3. **HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION**

For Disodium metasilicate

Contains Disodium Metasilicate. This can cause irritation to the skin and therefore the product is classified as IRRITANT. Do not mix with other chemicals, particularly acids as chlorine gas could be liberated and if inhaled could damage the mucous membranes

4. **FIRST AID MEASURES**

Eyes:

Immediately irrigate with eyewash solution or clean water, holding eyelids apart for at least 10 minutes. Obtain immediate medical attention.

Skin:

Remove contaminated clothing. Wash off immediately with water.

Ingestion:

Wash out mouth with water, then give plenty of milk or water to drink and obtain urgent medical attention, showing the label where possible. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Do not induce vomiting.
